Requirements:

Lesaffre Yeast Corporation, a fast-paced, energetic organization with world-wide recognition, was residing in the less than desirable remnants of the old Universal Food Headquarters. The company was looking to consolidate its staff in a more efficient work environment that reflected its forward-thinking culture.

Recommendations:

The location for the new office space was an old service building in the City of West Allis; it was once used by Wisconsin Electric and had been transformed into a multi-tenant office building. The interior offered a 25-foot ceiling deck, skylights and open plan that would serve as a beautiful backdrop for the new modern furniture the company desired. The Schroeder Solutions' design team maximized the open appeal of the space with 51-inch panel heights for the majority of the work area. Where privacy was needed, such as in the accounting department, the design team specified higher panels but incorporated glass inserts to continue the open and airy feel.
